Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of San Diego will consider the adoption of Ordinance No. O-2010-11, pursuant to Section 99 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, to authorize execution of a Construction and Maintenance Agreement with San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) and North County Transit District (NCTD) for construction and maintenance of the Quiet Zone Project safety improvements, to authorize execution of a Construction and Maintenance Agreement with BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) for construction and maintenance of the Quiet Zone Project safety improvements, and execution of a Cooperation Agreement with the Redevelopment Agency for implementation of the Quiet Zone Project.

DOWNTOWN SAN DIEGO QUIET ZONE. The Project includes 12 of the 13 of the public right-of-way crossings north of the freight yard that are in the downtown redevelopment area, from the north side of the freight yard going north: Park Boulevard, Fifth and First avenues, Front Street, Kettner Boulevard and G Street, Market Street, Broadway and Ash, Beech, Cedar, Grape, Hawthorn and Laurel streets. Park Boulevard will be constructed to Quiet Zone requirements as a separate construction project.

*** Unless otherwise noticed or stated on the record at the hearing, if an ordinance is approved and introduced by the City Council, it will automatically be scheduled for a hearing by the City Council for final passage at 10:00 a.m. on the Tuesday two weeks after the subject hearing.**

The decision of the City Council is final.

COMMUNICATIONS

This item may begin at any time after the time specified. Any interested person may address the City Council to express support or opposition to this issue. **Time allotted to each speaker is determined by the Chair and, in general, is limited to three (3) minutes;** moreover, collective testimony by those in support or opposition shall be limited to no more than fifteen (15) minutes total per side.
